

## The City of Rossford, Ohio POLICE OFFICER (Lateral and Entry Level FT Positions) Apply by: 01/31/2022 (see details below)

The City of Rossford, Ohio (pop. 6299) is accepting applications for **both entry level and lateral** full-time positions of Police Officer. Applicants must be at least 21 years of age; possess a valid Ohio driver's license; have no felony record or convictions of a crime of violence and possess a minimum of a high school diploma or equivalent. The compensation package includes a pay range of \$25.64 – \$33.12 per hour, depending on qualifications, education and experience, with excellent benefits. Up to 3 years of prior service may be awarded to successful applicants for pay rate and leave benefits.

Entry Level applicants must successfully complete a written test, PHQ and Public Safety Self-Assessment through the National Testing Network, Inc. To schedule a test, go to <a href="www.nationaltestingnetwork.com">www.nationaltestingnetwork.com</a>, select Law Enforcement and sign up for the Rossford Police Department. Testing must be completed no later than Monday, January 31, 2022. Successful completion of a <a href="physical fitness">physical fitness</a> assessment is also required for entry level applicants and will be conducted on a date to be determined. The location for the physical fitness assessment will be provided to those applicants who successfully complete the written test. A physician's release is required to participate in the fitness assessment. All applicants must submit a city employment application to be considered. This application and the physician's release can be found on our website at <a href="www.rossfordohio.com">www.rossfordohio.com</a>.

Lateral applicants with a minimum of two (2) years, full-time service as an accredited peace officer, are not required to complete the written test or physical fitness assessment to be considered for employment. However, they will be required to submit a City Application which is available at www.rossfordohio.com. Upon application, they may be required to submit a Personal History Questionnaire to be considered. If selected, prior service will be taken into consideration towards starting pay and leave benefits.
